

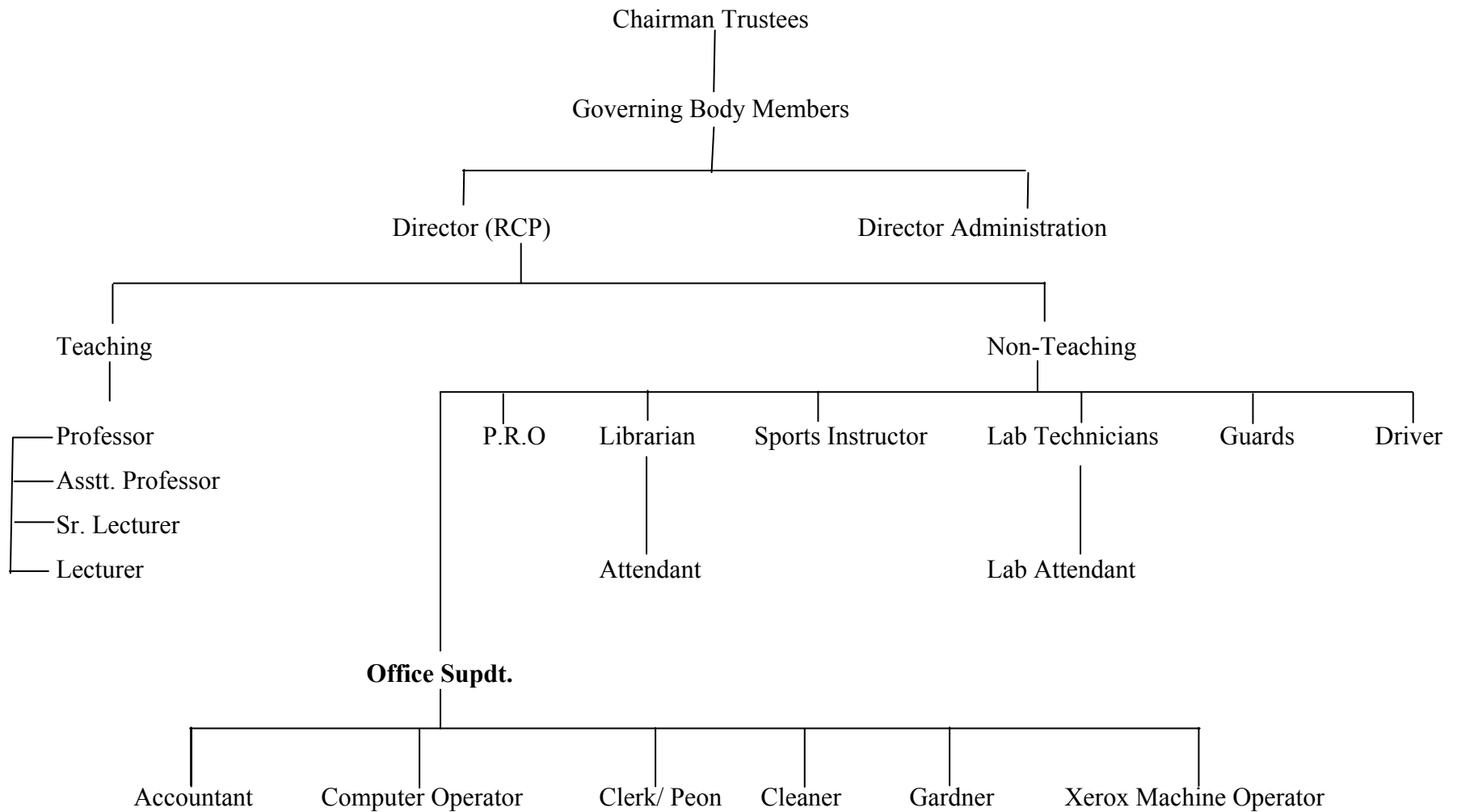

The Advisor helps the students in :


- * *Assisting Orientation*
